### The West Ranch Town Council 2008 Election Date Set

The West Ranch Town Council is announcing that the 2008 Election date will be November 4, 2008. The West Ranch Town Council, an advisory council for Los Angeles County Supervisor Michael Antonovich, is holding this election to fill four seats on the Council whose 4 year term is expiring in 2008.

Because the West Ranch Town Council is an advisory council and not an official legislative organization, the election is being held independently of the National, State, and Local election on that date. Polling location(s) for the WRTC 2008 election are still being determined but will be announced via a press release and posting on the WRTC web site prior to the election. The polling location(s) will be located within the western Santa Clarita Valley communities represented by the West Ranch Town Council; Sunset Pointe, Southern Oaks, Stevenson Ranch, and Westridge.

The West Ranch Town Council also has approved the application process needed for those who are interested in running for one of these open seats. An application is posted on the West Ranch Town Council web site ([www.WestRanchTownCouncil.com](http://www.WestRanchTownCouncil.com)) for downloading. The application needs to be completed and submitted along with the required non-refundable application fee for processing prior to September 30, 2008 to the West Ranch Town Council. The applications are available now for downloading.

Eligible applicants need to be a registered voter and have been a legal resident of one of the communities that comprise the West Ranch Town Council service area for a period of at least one year prior to the submission of the application. Submitted applications will be reviewed for adherence to the requirements. If the applicant meets all of the requirements, they will be included on the November ballot.

The four candidates that garner the most votes will be named the winners of the Council seats.
